We are seeking to appoint a Science Technician from September 2019 (maternity cover). This is a part time post (35 hours per week, 40 weeks per year) and we would prefer an applicant who has laboratory experience.

In Years 7 and 8, students study our own bespoke KS3 Science course. From Year 9 to Year 11, all students study separate sciences, following the AQA GCSE specifications. More than half of all Science GCSEs are awarded grades 7 to 9. The department also offers GCSE Astronomy.

A very large proportion of students continue to study the Sciences at A level with a number going on each year to study Science at Oxford and Cambridge. At A level the OCR syllabus A is followed for the Biology, Chemistry and Physics courses. In both Years 12 and 13 there are four teaching sets for Biology and Chemistry. There are three teaching sets in both Years 12 and 13 for Physics.

Devonport High School for Boys is an over-subscribed, selective school graded as 'outstanding' by Ofsted in February 2011. It is housed in 200 year old buildings of historic significance in an oasis of calm in the south west of the thriving, naval city of Plymouth, within easy access to the beautiful scenery of Devon and Cornwall.
